## **About the Conference**


The architecture of the second half of the 20th century exists between history and the present. This state of suspension means that we do not always know how to study, evaluate and protect it.

The aim of our conference is to present different issues and perspectives, to exchange knowledge and experiences and, above all, to establish new scientific relationships that may lead to joint research in the future.


We have divided our meeting into three parts:
